The emphasis is on the practical demonstration of skills & knowledge based on the performance criteria. Online examination (Multiple choice and true/false type questions) will be conducted to assess the knowledge gained by assessed. Duration of exam will be 90 minutes and maximum marks would be 100. Exam will cover all units.

Pass percentage

To qualify for a pass, a candidate must have obtained at least 50% marks in the online exam.

The marks will be translated into grades, while communicating results to the candidates. No rounding takes place in the calculation of grades. The gradation structure is as given below -

The assessment results are backed by following evidences.

1. In case of candidates trained by institutes authorized by NIELIT, the In-charge / Head of the Training Centre forwards the assessment request submitted by the assessed, on completion of training.
2. In case of direct candidate, the assessed himself/herself need to submit the assessment request.
3. The assessor assigns roll number on accepting the assessment request of the assessed.
4. The assessor verifies the authenticity of the assessed by checking the admit card which is generated based on the information submitted by assessed along with assessment request and also from any one valid Photo ID card issued by the Central/Government.
5. The attendance sheet bears the details of assessed including photograph. Signature of the assessed is obtained on the attendance sheet based on which presence of candidate in assessment process is confirmed.
6. The invigilator during the assessment checks the identity of the candidate from the photo of the candidate which is displayed on the monitor during the assessment process.
7. The performance of the assessed is tabulated using automated process.
